Each CCS case should be completed within the provided time limit. Review of a CCS case material should take 30 minutes to 1 hour.



Completing a 40Q QBank block in tutor mode should take 2-3 hours, allowing time to read explanations and make flashcards. Completing a 40Q timed block should take 1 hour, with 1-2 hours allotted for review.

When doing CCS cases, have a set of basic labs and nursing interventions that you order for every case; this will differ between adult and pediatric. Then, add in the orders that are specific to the chief complaint.

The best time to take Step 3 is mid-way through intern year on a low-stress clinical or research rotation.

By the last two weeks of studying, you should be scoring >75% on timed CCS cases.



Step 3 is a two day exam. **Day 1:** Approximately 232 MCQs, divided into six 60-minute blocks. The Day 1 test session is approximately 7 hours. **Day 2:** Approximately 180 MCQs, divided into six 45-minute blocks and 13 computer-based case simulations (CCS); each simulation is allotted a maximum of 10 or 20 minutes of real time. The Day 2 test session is approximately 9 hours.
